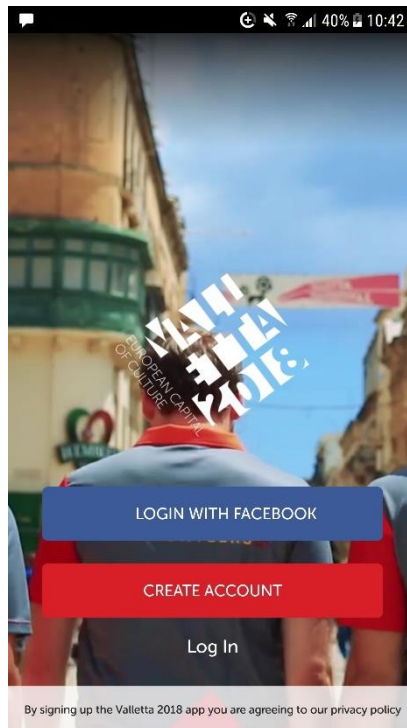


The Valletta 2018 App User Manual

What is the Valletta 2018 App for?

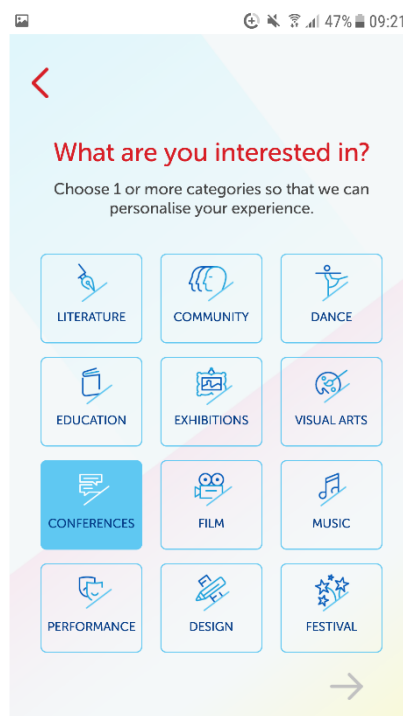
The Valletta 2018 App is primarily used to keep up to date with Valletta 2018 events and to purchase tickets to events. Users can login either through Facebook or by creating an account as per below:

Login with Facebook or Create an Account

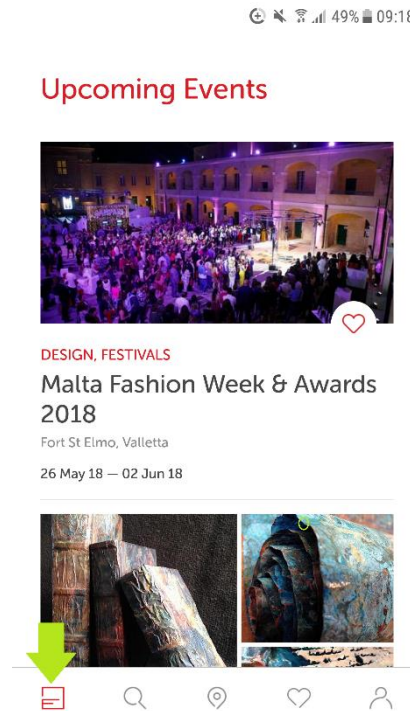


The App allows users to select categories they are interested in; therefore, users can browse which category of event they would like to view, and the App will display what events are occurring. Users can click a category in order to personalise their experience, thus displaying the events of their first category more prominently in the App.

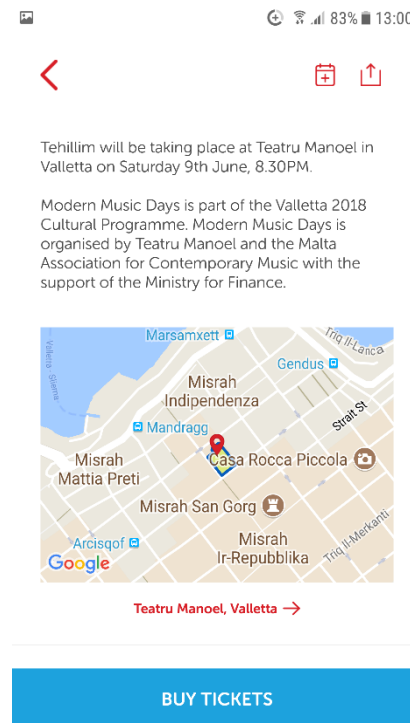
Select the category you are most interested in to personalise your experience

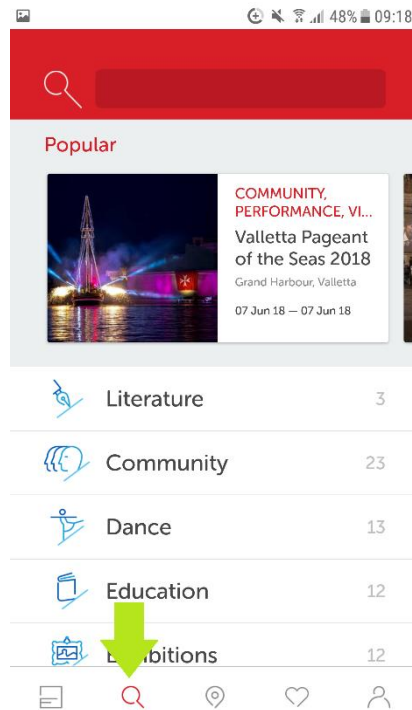


The App has 5 main screens:



The **first screen** shows users a list of all the events offered by Valletta 2018 and which are on the Valletta 2018 website. Events are sorted by **Category** and **Date**. When you click on an event, it shows the user a description, a map of the location where the event will be held, and a ticket button (if the event requires a ticket for entry), as in the below:





In the second screen, users can browse events by **Category** by clicking on the category of event they prefer. This will take them to the corresponding events which fall under the category they select.



The third screen takes users to a map. Here, users can browse the map and click on the **green** locations.

Click on the location



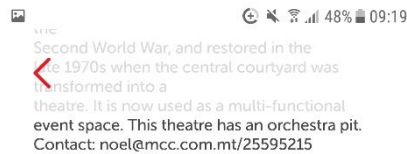

Mediterranean Conference Centre

The building which now houses the Mediterranean Conference Centre was constructed in the 16th century by the Order of St John to be used as a hospital, which was known as the Sacra Infermeria. It remained in use as a hospital until the early 20th century. The building was badly damaged during the Second World War, and restored in the late 1970s when the central courtyard was transformed into a theatre. It is now used as a multi-functional event space. 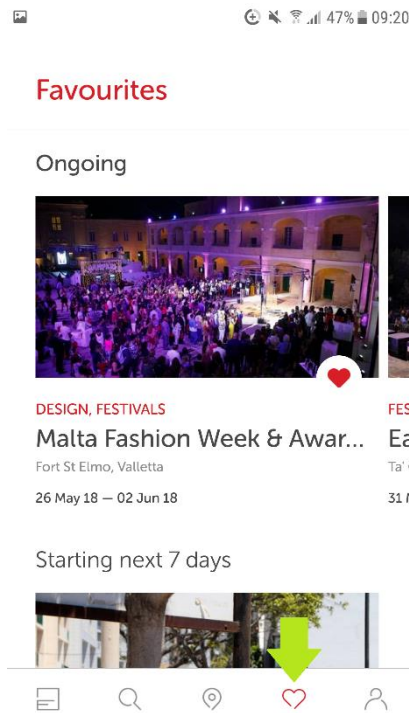

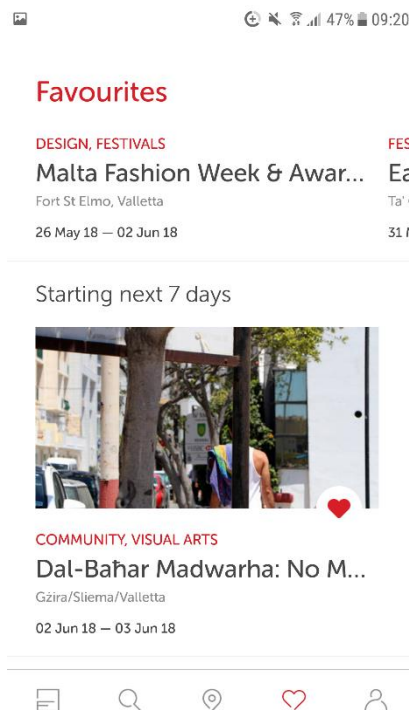

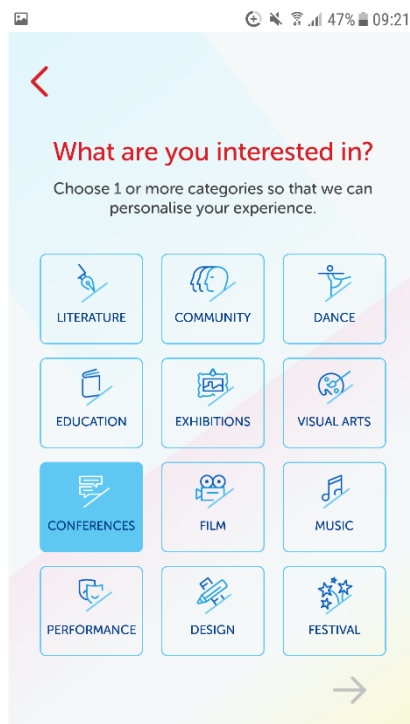
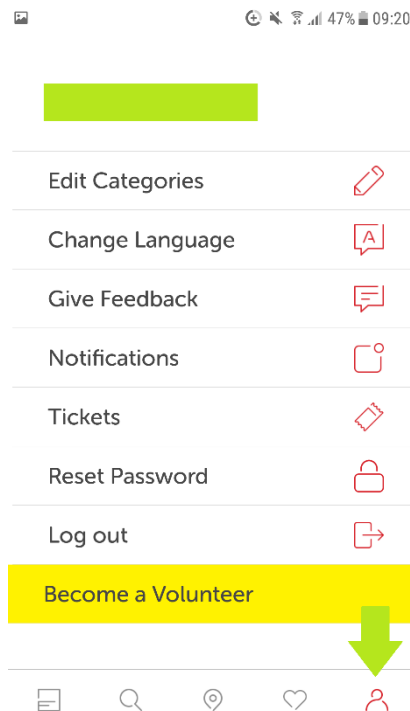
The **fourth** screen below shows how users can view their favourite events. These are selected by clicking on the heart symbol on the left-hand side of each event. This screen will show the user which events they have clicked the heart symbol on.



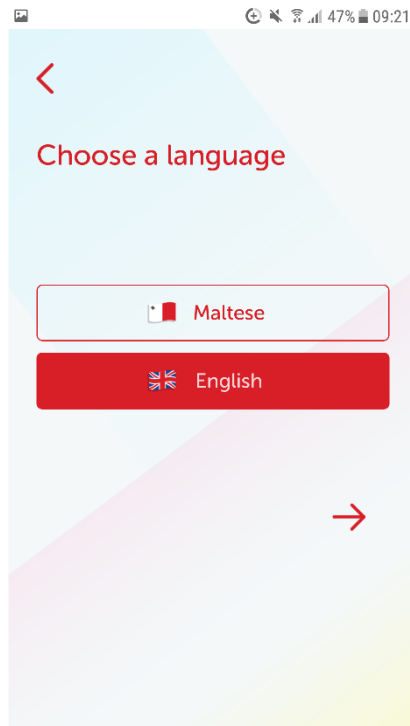
If you scroll down on this screen, it will show you favourite events starting in the next 7 days.



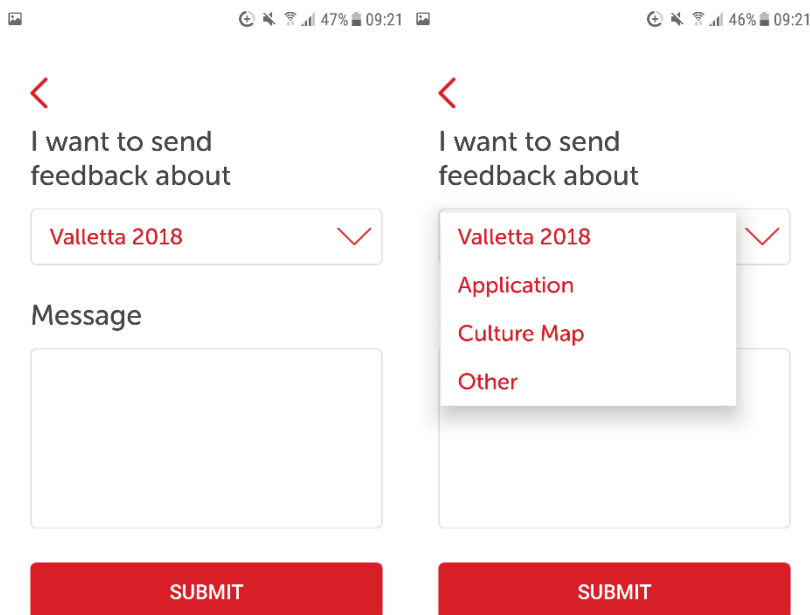
The **fifth** screen gives users a variety of options. Here users can edit categories, change language (App is available either in Maltese or English), send feedback, check App notifications, buy event tickets, reset their password, log out or register to become a Valletta 2018 Tal-Kultura volunteer.



By clicking on Edit Categories, users can select 1 or more categories to personalise their App viewing experience.



Here users can select which language they prefer to view the App in (Maltese or English).

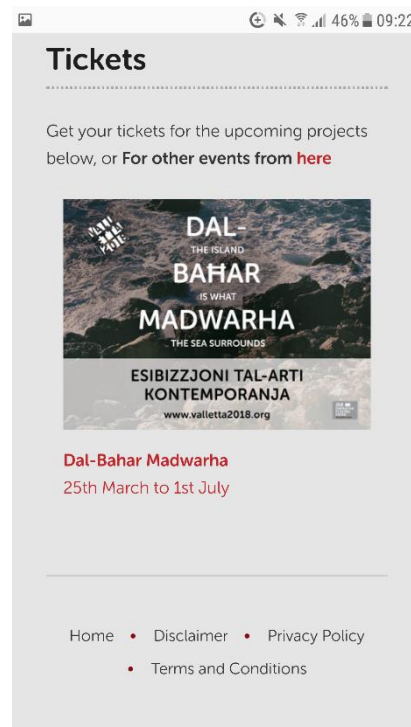
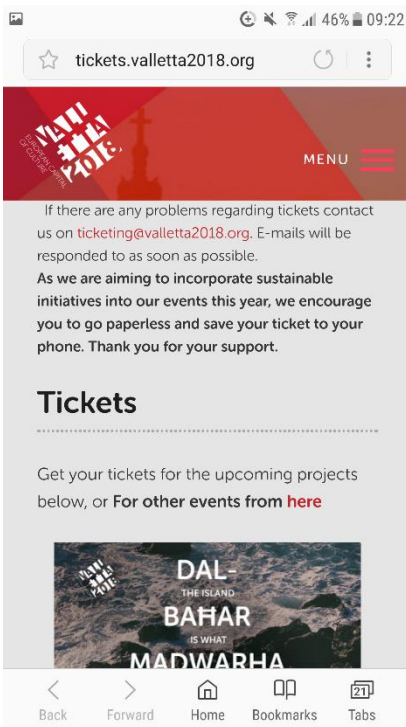


Users can send feedback to Valletta 2018 by clicking the next option on the fifth screen. Users have four options of types of feedback to select from.

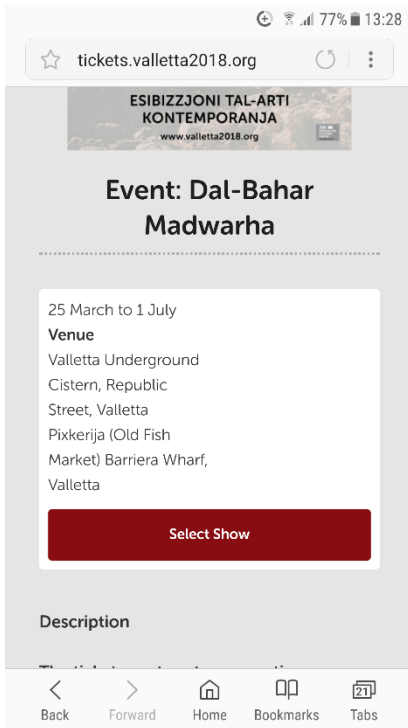
< Notifications

The notifications tab will direct users to any notifications they receive via the Valletta 2018 App.

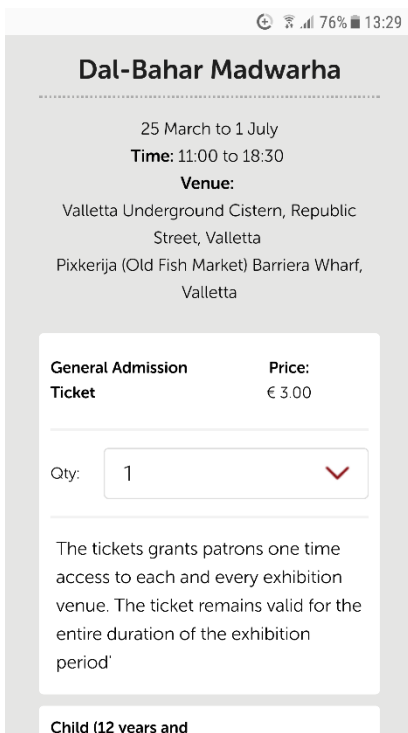
By clicking on the Tickets tab, users will be redirected to an external webpage (tickets.valletta2018.org) which contains all ticketed events organised by Valletta 2018. This same screen also provides users with another link (see For other events) – this leads to events on the Valletta 2018 website which do not form part of the Valletta 2018 ticketing system.



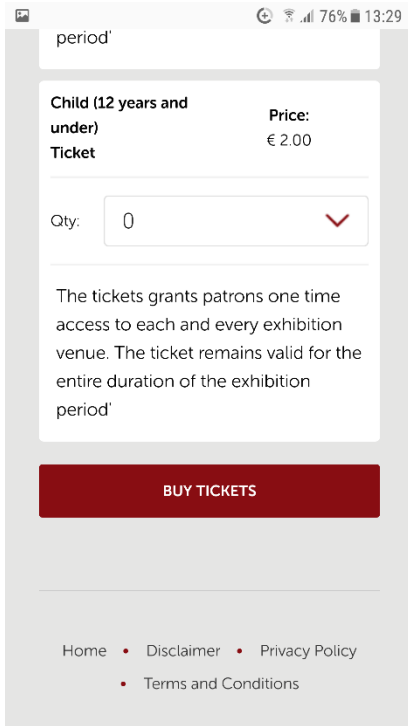
After you click on the event you want to buy tickets for, it leads to the below:



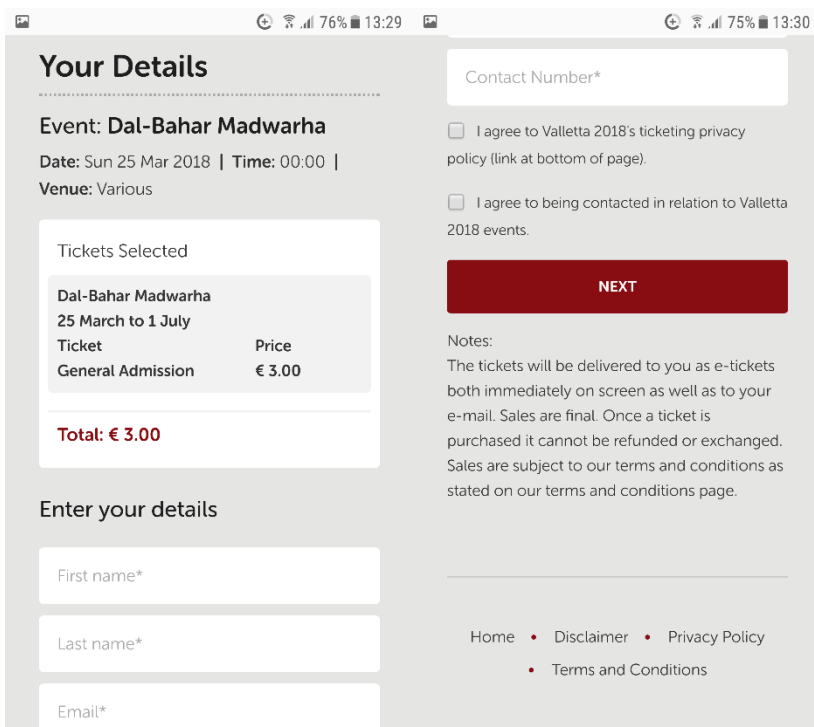
Here users can select the show they want to purchase tickets for.



Here users can select the quantity of tickets they require.

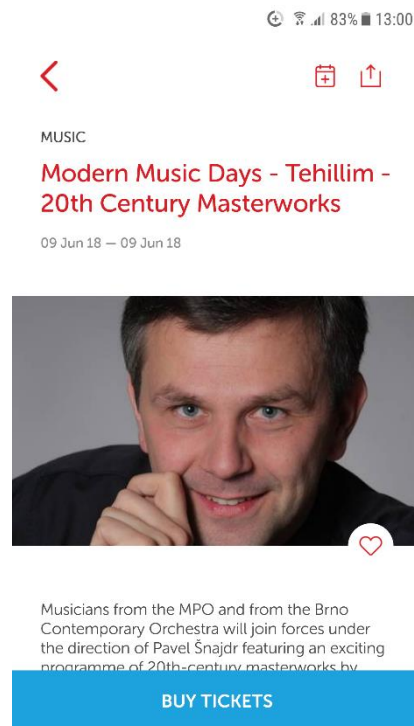


Scroll down and click on "Buy Tickets".



Fill in your details and click "Next" to buy your tickets.

Apart from buying tickets this way, users also have the option to buy tickets from the event page itself, as seen in the below:



This will redirect the user to the external webpage in which they can buy tickets from.

The last tab on this screen leads to an application form for Tal-Kultura volunteers. Here users can click a category of event they would prefer to volunteer in and submit their application.
